ITINERARY (Continued)

Day 6 - Beppu - Nagasaki:

The highlight of today might just be our first port of call – the Hells of Beppu (onsen) for the magnificent views . We'll continue on to Nagasaki, famous for its cultural and historical heritage and the birth place of Christianity in Japan. Visit the Nagasaki Atomic Bomb Museum to learn of the devastating effects of the atomic bomb dropped here on August 9, 1945. Hotel: 3 Hotel Jal City Nagasaki or Similar (B)

Day 7 - Nagasaki:

Take a short drive to visit the magnificent Glover Garden and then visit the oldest church in Japan, the Basilica of the Twenty-Six Holy Martyrs of Japan. After lunch (own cost), we enjoy a cruise around the fascinating Hashima Island, or Gunkanjima, before heading to Dejima, a fan-shaped artificial island built to separate the local population from the Europeans. **Hotel:** 3* Hotel Jal City Nagasaki or Similar (B)

This evening enjoy OBE/WAGYU BEEF DINNER IN OSAKA . **Hotel:** 3* Hotel Links Namba, or similar (B)

Day 11 - Osaka - Kanazawa:

Visit the stunning Kenrokuen Garden. Later visit Nomura Samurai House. Finish the day in the Higashi Chaya District of Kanazawa ,historically home to many teahouses where geisha would perform. **Hotel**: 3* Hotel Resol Trinity Kanazawa, or similar (B)

Day 12 - Kanazawa - Shirakawago - Takayama - Nagano:

Travel to Shirakawa-gō Village with 100 'Gassho-style' houses. From the site's observation deck you can enjoy a panoramic view of this unique village From here we'll head to Takayama's Old Town, a wonderfully well-preserved slice of old Japan. **Hotel**: 3* Nagano Tokyu Rei Hotel, or similar (B)

Day 13 - Nagano - Matsumoto - Mt Fuji - Hakone:
